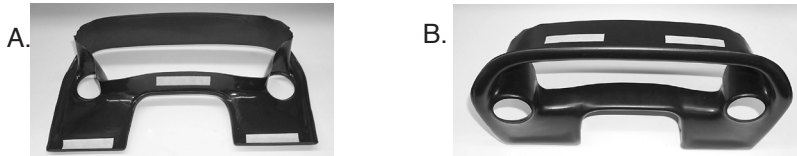


Installation of new bezel

1. Test fit bezel in dash with gauges installed to assure clearance (see note below).
2. Install gauges in bezel. Following gauge installation instructions (use of gauge mounting brackets is not required), run wiring down between dash and instrument cluster.
3. Clean factory bezel and back of gauge bezel with glass cleaner where tape will be applied.
4. Place tape on bezel as shown in illustrations A and B.
5. Peel backing from tape and install Gauge Bezel. Try to align the bridge behind the steering column first. This will align the entire bezel to the dash.



NOTE: Gauges requiring a compression fitting will need to use a model 3272 (90°) fitting to clear the instrument cluster.

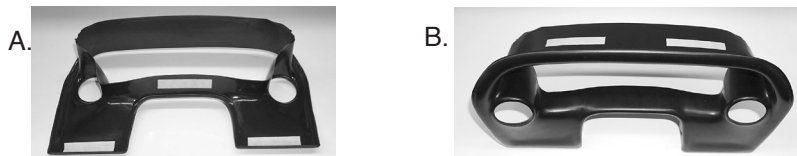
